### Provider number - legal requirement

A separate provider number is required for each location. You will need to fill out the PDF form for your first provider number. Subsequent provider numbers can be applied for online through HPOS.

You will only need to do this once as it will remain the same regardless of your provider number.

Unless you are setting up a new practice, your employer or practice principal will need to add you as an operator to their current licence

An accountant is strongly recommended for those employed/contracted in private practice on commission. Note that the fees for an accountant or tax agent are tax deductible.
